The personal information provided by you in this Nomination for Membership will be used to process your membership application. You are not obliged to complete those details which you do not wish to disclose, but this may mean that your nomination is delayed, or possibly rejected.

You have the right to access and amend any of the personal information held by the Club.

The Club must protect the privacy of the information which is collected, stored, used or disclosed. The Club will do this by taking reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information which you give to the Club is protected against any misuse, loss, unauthorised access or disclosure.

As part of the nomination for membership, and in accordance with the Club Constitution, your name will be placed on the Club's noticeboard, in the Annual Report and on the Private members section of the Club's website.

The Club will not usually disclose your personal information to any other organisation or person unless there is a legal requirement to do so.

Membership Details

Membership Categories and Rights

ORDINARY MEMBER: Any person over the age of 18 years:

- Is entitled to a vote;
- Is entitled to discount prices at the bar and for functions;
- Is entitled to hold office; and
- Is entitled to enjoy the privileges of the Club such as participating in Sailing Races, Regattas or Training.

LIFE MEMBER: Any member who has given outstanding service to the Club may be elected to Life Membership by the members at a General Meeting of the Club. An Ordinary Member may nominate a person for Life Membership to the Management Committee who will decide whether or not to recommend the nomination to a General Meeting. A Life Member shall:

- Exercise the right of an Ordinary Member; and
- Be exempt from paying membership fees.

JUNIOR MEMBER: Any person under 18 years provided that person:

- Shall not have voting rights;
- Shall not hold office;
- Can participate in Sailing Races, Regattas or Training if accompanied by an Ordinary or Life Member; and
- Is permitted to enter the Clubroom but is not allowed in the Bar area unless accompanied by an adult or parent.
- This category of member does not have the authority to invite guests to The Club.
- Any Junior member on attaining the age of 18 years wishing to remain a member of The Club shall be granted the appropriate club membership and shall pay the full subscription as set down from time to time.

CORPORATE MEMBER: Any Corporation conducting community or tourism related business in Exmouth and its surrounds, and interested in promoting the welfare of the Club through business, sponsorship or donations, but does not wish to participate in management or competition activities. The Club will only recognize the most senior President, Executive, Director, Manager etc. on behalf of a Corporate Member in the Exmouth locality in respect of membership benefits. Such Corporation through its approved identified nominee:

- Is not entitled to a vote;
- Is not entitled to hold any office;
- May not participate in Sailing Races, Regattas or Training; and
- Is not eligible to participate in membership draws.
- Will have membership restricted at any one time to a level deemed appropriate by the Club or as may be required by the Liquor Licensing Authority.

CONCESSION: Available to local residents only and refers to Age Pension or Disability.

Other Membership Details

The period of financial membership is 1 July to 30 June.
The membership subscription fee (if applicable) is payable in advance.

When the application form and all subscriptions have been received, the person shall be a provisional member of the club and exercise all of the privileges of a member excluding voting rights until such time as the next Management Committee meeting.

- (ii) At the next Management Committee meeting, the applicant will then be accepted or denied membership.
(iii) If membership is denied, all subscriptions shall be refunded.

Subscriptions must be paid within two weeks of acceptance and shall be paid as follows:

- (i) If accepted between 1 July and 30 September – Full annual subscription
(ii) If accepted between 1 October and 31 December – 75% annual subscription
(iii) If accepted between 1 January and 31 March – 50% annual subscription
(iv) If accepted between 1 April and 30 June – 25% annual subscription

Guests – Ordinary, Corporate and Life Members shall be at liberty to invite guests to The Club, but the number of guests shall not exceed the maximum number as contained in Section 48(4)(b) of the Liquor Act (currently five guests per member). A guest may attend the club a maximum of 3 times before they must apply for membership.
